ADMINISTRATIVE HOUSEKEEPING

D. Cracknell opened the floor, no discussion.

1. MOTION TO MOVE DECEMBER MONTHLY MEETING TO DECEMBER 19

D. Cracknell had talked about moving the December date up at the last meeting.

D. Cracknell motioned to approve the Dec. 19 date for the Regular Meeting; B. Hunt seconded.

APPROVED: 5-0.

2. MANAGER'S REPORT

A. Monthly Report

Total active customers - 728; Total Water Sales Revenue - \$13,757.27; Total Base Service - \$31143.07; Total Tax collected - \$2,944.14; Total Current charges - \$53,319.39.

Average water bill \$67.74; Total Gallons pumped - 2,683,070; Total Gallons Sold - 2,086,816; Accounted Water Loss - 93,000; Unaccounted Water Loss - 503,254; **PERCENT WATER LOSS - 19.00%**. Read 35 days from 9-16 to 10-15.

Behind Wades Furniture store, on Rhinestone Dr. 9-18, 4" main 30,000 gallons, called out 10:00AM. Wades #2 9-18, 4" main 30,000 gal., called out 6:30 PM. Wades #3 9-19, 4" main 30,000 gal. called out 7:00 AM. Wades #4 9-23 replaced 48 feet of transite main with 4" C-900, 5,000 gal. Caused by Juniper tree's roots, previous main breaks within 20 feet of each other, removed trees. K. Womack asked if previous repair clamps were taken out and will be reused; yes, restocked in pump house. K. Womack stated that a neighbor claims trees are not a problem, Don said all the Juniper trees on Opal Dr. were planted on the water main, could be a problem. 1145 Rose Quartz blue poly service, 10-5, 3,000 gal.

Three new hook-ups; applications 3 owners and 4 renters. Changed out 2 dead meters. Water quality tests were good for total Coliform (two per month). Did leak detection at 4 homes on Douglas, none found.

B. Capital Improvements Progress Report: showed a photograph of an easement problem at 5011 & 5027 Regina Ct. showing how the main may be going under Pine trees across a property, 9' - 9"

inside their fence, about 6 feet from their back door. There is no indication this is an easement according to plat map, Unit 2. Need to explore if this is a legal easement, possible relocation of main. Don stated it's a main that serves Catherine Dr. (Unit 7), could be difficult to re-route. [need to verify address # and lot #, see below]

C. Rose Quartz Emergency Pipe Replacement Project: The 8" main was put into service 10-24, still need to finish up with re-plumbing service lines. Should be complete by 10-28. One existing service was buried only a few inches deep.

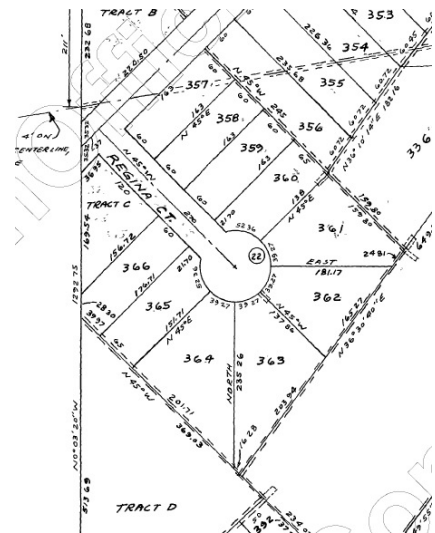
